



To: Car owners – KJR FM Car Show on June 19th

First, thanks for your entry and participation, and for your patience as we develop this new show in a new venue. The Everett Events Center is a great facility in downtown Everett – easy to find –map and driving directions are enclosed.

The KJR FM crew are great to work with and you'll enjoy meeting their DJ's on-site during the day. Pat Cashman begins the day and Bob Case ends it with presentation of People's Choice awards. *(No fair stuffing the ballot box – but how would we know).*

- Public show hours are Saturday only: 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
- Move-in hours are from 12:00 Noon FRIDAY to 8:00 p.m. unless you have been notified differently.
- Each owner is provided 2 wrist bands as admission passes. This will allow you to come in after 8:00 a.m. on Saturday to work on your cars if you wish to, and to come and go during the day.
- EEC house rules preclude you from bringing in ice chests, coolers, nor outside food.

SPECIAL NOTE FOR DRIVING INTO LOAD-IN AREA – (driving directions on separate sheet)

- **Driving directions provided by EEC direct you to main public entrance. For load-in, we need you to be on opposite corner of building (SE). Broadway is two-way street and very busy. We have reserved curbside parking area adjacent to building on Broadway. Please enter SOUTHBOUND on Broadway beginning at Hewitt and pull into right hand curbside lane. It will be marked with cones and a volunteer will guide you to entry into load-in parking area.**
- Enclosed is a colored sheet with your number on it. Please **display this in the window** as you pull into the line so that the second volunteer can direct you into one of two lines in the loading dock area. One line is for NORTH hall and one is for SOUTH hall. We may make exceptions on site so bear with us.
- FUEL CHECKS, license plate match and verification of waiver signature will take place in this line.
NOTE: Everett Fire Marshall regulations are different from Seattle and Tacoma in that they want full tanks – NOT topped off – and not more than 20 gallons should your tanks be larger.
Bob Austin, of TFC Staff, will check each car for fuel and verification of waivers. NO car admitted into building without Bob's check.
- Payment of Entry Fee will be collected at this point unless you have previously mailed your check.
Make check for \$20.00 payable to: Clear Channel Radio/ KJRFM
- Once in position, you will be then asked to pull and wrap the battery cable (Negative only) and be available for inspection by fire marshal. If you have a shut-off switch, please notify the volunteer supervising your area.
- Gas caps must be properly sealed. **WARNING: The Fire Marshall indicates that any car leaking gas at any time will be immediately removed from the building by either the owner, Fire Dept. or our staff.**

- Drip pans or diapers: while your car may not be guilty, please bring just in case, especially for cars in the east hall where a cover is placed over ice rink.
- Each car will be provided a window card showing your ID# assigned, year, make, model and owner. This will be in packet given you on arrival along with wrist bands. If we have made any errors on The sign, please advise us and we'll make new, corrected ones. If you do not want owner's name to appear, please let us know this as well.
- Keys: Once you are parked in a display position and your window card is posted, we will check. When you are completed with your preparations, please your extra key with either Bob Junell or Bob Austin, or the designated volunteer for this purpose. Your key will be left under lock with security for emergency use only. The Fire Department and Bob Junell will be the only persons with access. The key will be returned to you after 4:00 p.m. and before move-out.
- **Trailers or transporters:** if you are bringing in your car by trailer or transport, please contact me in advance so we can make arrangements. You will need to pull into loading dock, unload and in a reasonable time pull your trailer out. We'll show you a nearby parking lot available for this purpose. **IMPORTANT that you advise me in advance.**

Location

The Everett Events Center, located in Snohomish County, is situated in downtown Everett in the Puget Sound area. Positioned a mere 23 miles north of Seattle, Washington, the Everett Events Center will be the premier sports and entertainment venue in the region. In addition to drawing from Snohomish County, the Everett Events Center will also attract people from King County, which is south of Snohomish County. With no other comparable venue within 112 miles north of Everett, the venue will also draw from Skagit County and Whatcom County.

The Everett Events Center is conveniently located in downtown Everett at the crossroads of Hewitt and Broadway, just blocks from Interstate 5. Quick access on and off the freeways from multiple directions will make arrivals and departures for large events a breeze. Either the Broadway Exit or the City Center Exit

Take I-5 South to Exit number 194 - US-2/Everett Avenue . Take the Everett Avenue ramp towards the City Center . Turn right onto Everett Avenue . Turn left onto Broadway Avenue . Turn right onto Hewitt Avenue . Conference Center entrance is at Hewitt and Lombard Avenues.

From the South

Take I-5 North to exit number 193 - Pacific Avenue exit. Turn left onto Pacific Avenue . Turn right onto Broadway Avenue . Turn left onto Hewitt Avenue . Conference Center entrance is at Hewitt and Lombard Avenues.

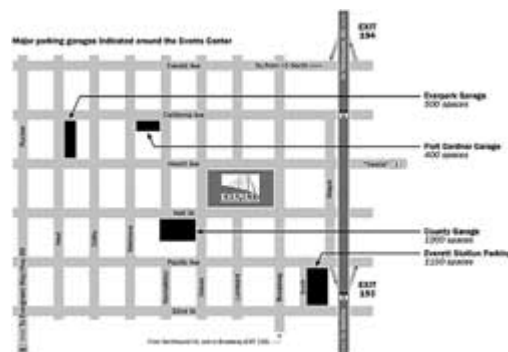
From the East

Merge onto US-2 West. Turn slight left to take the I-5 S ramp toward Seattle/ Everett/Hewitt Avenue. Take the ramp toward Hewitt Avenue/City Center. Turn slight right onto California Street. Turn left onto Maple Street/WA-529. Turn right onto Hewitt Avenue/US-2.

Parking

There are over 5,000 parking spaces within walking distance of the Everett Event Center. In addition, there are designated disabled parking spaces available for vehicles displaying valid identification. Some events may offer the opportunity to purchase parking prior to an event.

Reserved parking is exclusive for Premium Seat holders and is located in the County Parking garage directly across the street from the Suite Entrance.
